COPD or Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease is an umbrella term used to describe progressive lung diseases, encompassing emphysema, chronic bronchitis, refractory asthma, and severe bronchiectasis.



COPD Facts

- 16 million adults have COPD, millions more are undiagnosed
- COPD is 4th leading cause of death in the United States
- Every 4 minutes someone dies of COPD in the US
- Rate of COPD is 3.5 times higher in those with incomes under \$25,000
- COPD costs between 40-70 million annually in US, with majority of costs due to hospitalization
